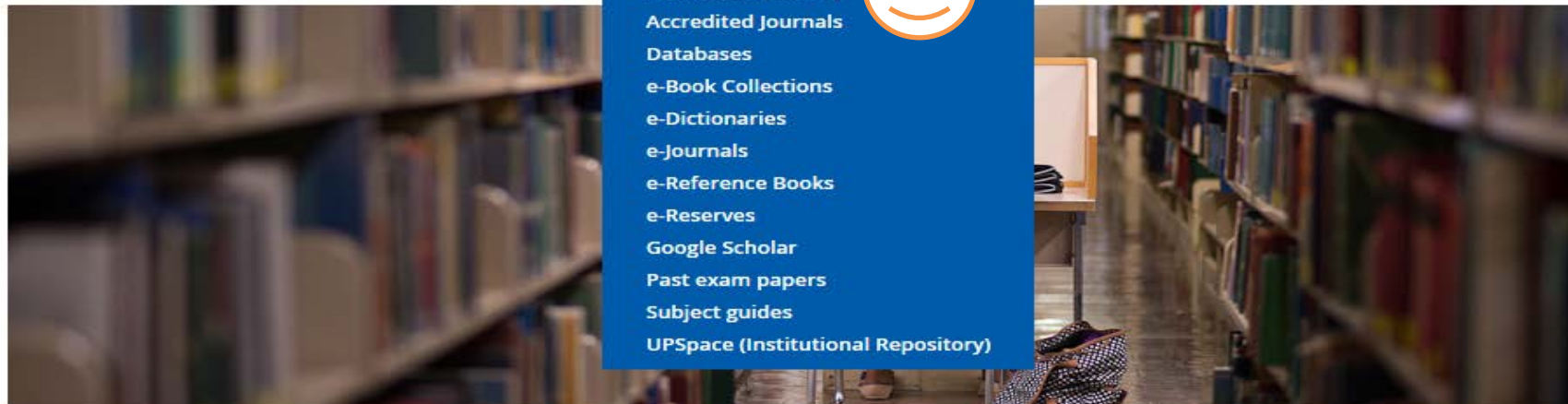

Step 2. Searching the Legislation. Acts – called Legislation or Statutes. (You may use the hardcopies or the online material)

For the **hardcopies** use the indexes available in the Statutes books themselves. These include Alphabetical and Chronological (by year) indexes.


There are 4 databases for searching for **online legislation**. The 3 below are subscription databases and one is free online: <http://www.lawsofsouthafrica.up.ac.za/>

 Use **Sabinet Legal (Netlaw)** Search for an Act title: “*Marriage Act*” or search Act number and year: **25 1961**.


