

Directions to the Faculty of Veterinary Science, University of Pretoria. (Onderstepoort Campus)

GPS Coordinates : 25° 38' 52" South and 28° 10' 54" East

From UP main gate: Take Lynnwood Road in a westerly direction. Turn right into University Road. Turn left in Burnett Street. This becomes Park Street. Turn right into Beatrix Street which becomes Voortrekkers Rd later on. Continue over the Magaliesberg and follow Lavender Rd until there is a slipway to the left on to the R101 (Signboard : R101 - Hammanskraal, Wonderboom Airport). Continue with the R101 until there is a sign board to slip left on to the R566/Rosslyn road. Cross over the Apies River and you will come to a traffic light. Continue west towards Rosslyn (sign board). Cross the railway bridge and at the traffic light turn right to Onderstepoort/Soutpan (M35). The first traffic light on the M35 is at the entrance to the Onderstepoort Veterinary Institute. Proceed to the next traffic light. The entrance to the Faculty of Veterinary Science, University of Pretoria, is on your left.

From N1 - Zambesi off ramp: Take the Zambesi Drive off ramp. Follow Zambesi drive in a westerly direction until you reach Lavender Rd (R101) (±14km) . Turn right into Lavender Rd and continue till R566 (Rosslyn turn off). Use the slipway into the R566 and continue with the R566 till M35 (Onderstepoort / Soutpan turn off). Turn right into the M35 and proceed past the first traffic light. At the second traffic light the entrance to the Faculty of Veterinary Science, University of Pretoria is on your left. The Library is in the Sir Arnold Theiler Building on levels 4 and 5.

From N1/N4 West: From the N 1 highway take the N4 West (Rustenburg) highway . Proceed with the N4 and take the Onderstepoort/ Rosslyn / Pretoria off ramp (R566). At the junction with the R566 turn to your right. Proceed until you reach the M35 (Soutpan turn off). Take the slipway to the left. Proceed past the first traffic light. The entrance to the Faculty of Veterinary Science is on the left at the second traffic light. The library is in the Sir Arnold Theiler building on levels 4 and 5.
