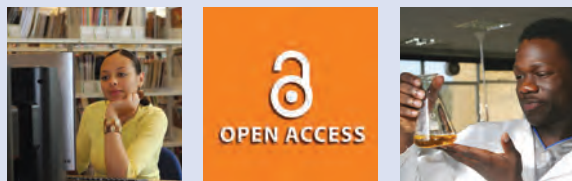


What is openUP?

openUP is the **open access** collection of the **full text** of published **research articles** authored and co-authored by UP staff and students. It forms part of UPSpace, the university's digital research repository. The articles in this collection are **freely available** to everyone and can be retrieved without passwords.



Why should I archive my articles?

There is increasing evidence that articles available in open access mode are **cited more** than those that are only available through traditional subscription services. By opening up your research results, you can reach a **wider audience** and may increase the **impact** of your research. The benefits for you as researcher are:

- increased visibility;
- more citations – as much as 286% - and more impact;
- it serves as a showcase of your research for an NRF rating;
- safe, central and long-term storage of your articles also linked to the UP Research Report.

Does UP management support openUP?

Yes, the Department of Library Services received a mandate from the UP management to manage the openUP programme and to develop the necessary policy to govern it. (*UP Strategic Plan 2007-2011, B6.6:*)

What about copyright?

Articles can only be deposited if:

- you as the author retain copyright, **or**
- the publisher permits depositing in a repository, **or**
- you have obtained permission from the publisher.

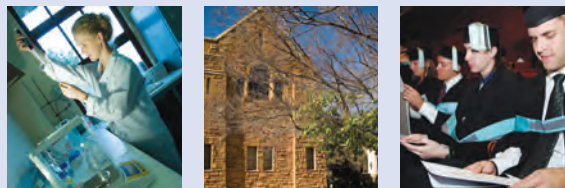
The majority of publishers allow the deposit of research articles in repositories under certain conditions (<http://www.sherpa.ac.uk/romeo/>) and others are willing to give permission. The openUP Office (openup@up.ac.za) will check these agreements for you or advise you on the process.

How do I deposit my research articles?

It is an easy process. Please consult the deposit guide <http://openup.ais.up.ac.za/docs/quickguide.pdf> and consider one of the following options:

- Self-deposit your articles;
- Appoint a submitter to deposit articles on your behalf;
- Send a copy of your final, edited and approved manuscript to openup@up.ac.za.

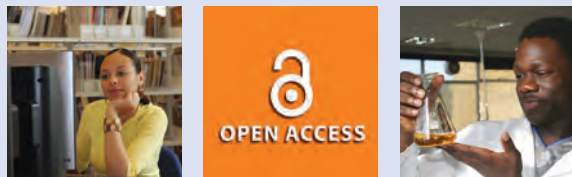

Wat is openUP?

openUP is 'n versameling **navorsingsartikels** gepubliseer deur personeel, studente en geaffilieerdes van die Universiteit van Pretoria. Dit word gehuisves in UPSpace, die digitale pakhuis van die universiteit. Die artikels in hierdie versameling ondersteun die beginsel van **oop toegang**, wat behels dat die inhoud **gratis beskikbaar** is op die Internet en maklik toeganklik is sonder wagwoorde.



Hoekom behoort ek my artikels te argiveer?

Daar is bewys dat artikels wat deur oop toegang beskikbaar is **meer aangehaal** word as artikels wat slegs op subskripsie databasisse toeganklik is. Deurdat u navorsingsartikels maklik soekbaar is op die Internet (met Google bv), **vergroot u leserkorps** en dit kan die **impak** van u navorsing verhoog. Die voordele vir u as navorser is:

- verhoogde sigbaarheid;
- meer aanhalings – tot 286% - en meer impak;
- dit dien as 'n vertoonkas vir al u navorsingsuitsette vir 'n NRF gradering;
- u navorsingsartikels word langdurig, veilig en sentraal bewaar, is soekbaar en gekoppel aan die UP Navorsingsverslag.

Wat van kopiereg?

openUP se beleid is om die bestaande kopieregvoorwaardes van uitgewers te volg. U artikels kan slegs geargiveer word indien:

- u as die outeur kopiereg behou, **of**
- die uitgewer u toelaat om u artikels in 'n pakhuis te argiveer, **of**
- u die toestemming van die uitgewer verkry het om u artikels op te laai.

Die meerderheid uitgewers stem reeds daartoe in dat artikels onder bepaalde omstandighede geargiveer mag word (<http://www.sherpa.ac.uk/romeo/>) en ander is gewillig om toestemming te verleen. Die openUP Kantoor (openup@up.ac.za) is bereid om namens u die kopieregvoorskrifte van uitgewers uit te klaar en te onderhandel en voorsien graag advies in die verband.

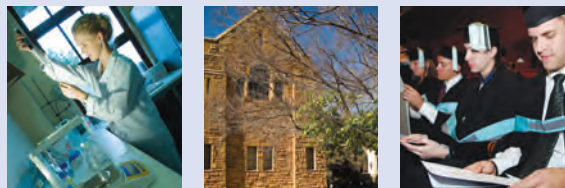
Hoe argiveer ek my navorsingsartikels?
